<u>10</u>	Totally Awesome (Almost Gross) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The writing goes beyond the basic understanding and shows in-depth understanding • The work shows in-depth reflection of the learning process • Color and labeled diagrams are present and used to enhance understanding • The pages of this unit have all of the expected components • Each page in the notebook is completed appropriately • The notebook is so exceptionally tidy it's "almost gross!"
<u>9</u>	Awesome <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The writing shows understanding of the content • The work shows reflection of the learning process • Color and labeled diagrams are present and used to enhance understanding • The pages of this unit have all of the expected components • Each page in the notebook is completed appropriately (partially complete does NOT count as complete) • The unit looks much like a "10" but lacks the "totally" in the awesome
<u>8</u>	Pretty Darn Good <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The written work shows a basic understanding of the content • An honest reflection is present • Some color and labeled diagrams are present • Most of the pages in this unit have the expected components • All but one or two pages in this section of the notebook are completed appropriately (partially complete does NOT count as complete)
<u>7</u>	Kick It Up a Notch <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The written work shows a limited understanding of the content and lacks depth • Little reflection is evident in the learning process • Little color and diagrams are present to help support learning • Some expected components are missing (titles, page numbers, etc.) • All but three or four pages in this section of the notebook are completed appropriately (partially complete does NOT count as complete) • The notebook is somewhat disorganized
<u>6</u>	Better Get Movin'! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The written work shows misconceptions and a lack of understanding • Reflection? What reflection? • No color or labeled diagrams that enhance learning are present • There are more than 4 missing or incomplete pages • Notebook requirements are rarely met
<u>5</u>	What We're You Thinking? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hey, you turned in a notebook, but so much is missing that perhaps you wrote with invisible ink?
